Summer Camp at Newfields Lottery Registration FAQs

Why did Newfields change the registration process?

Parents have told us that registration is the most uncertain part of participating in our Summer Camps. So we have created a new lottery-style application system to improve the experience by:

- Allowing families a longer time frame to register (about a week instead of a single day due to camps filling quickly).
- Giving families an equal chance to be enrolled in camp.
- Making it easier to register siblings for the same camp week.
- Providing more timely communication about waiting-list placement.

Do I have to be a member of Newfields to register for camp?

Yes. Registration is open only to members at the Family Level and above. Families will be required to submit their membership number on their lottery application. NOTE: In recent years, the number of people trying to register for summer camp has exceeded the number of spaces we have, so membership does not guarantee registration.

How does a registration lottery work?

The lottery-application window will be open for about a week. Each family should complete only one lottery application form, located at <u>www.discovernewfields.org/summer-camp</u>. Staff will randomly draw applications and process them until camp spots are filled. If a camp fills up, lottery applicants will be placed on a waiting list, based on the order that their application is processed. If any camp spots remain unfilled, they will be available for purchase online.

What is the registration timeline for the summer 2020 camps?

The lottery application window opens at 10 am on Tuesday, January 6, 2020, and closes at midnight Monday, January 13, 2020. Camp registrations will be processed during business hours January 14-21.

- January 6-13 The lottery application window opens.
 January 14-21 Newfields will randomize applications and process registrations.
 January 22-28 Newfields will send out wait-list positions to families whose applications were not selected.
- January 31 Any remaining camp spots will be available to purchase online.

How do I submit my lottery application?

The lottery application form is available at <u>www.discovernewfields.org/summer-camp</u>. Applications will only be accepted via the online form. If you have questions about your application, please email <u>IMASummerCamp@discovernewfields.org</u>. Please do not call the Museum or mail in your application.

How do I find out if I am registered for camp or placed on a wait list?

Newfields staff will reach out to families using the email address that is supplied on the lottery application form, according to the schedule listed above. If your child is registered for camp(s), you

will receive an emailed confirmation on or before January 21. If your child is placed on a waiting list, staff will reach out to you with information about your position on or before January 28. We will keep a separate waiting list for each camp.

Do I have a better chance in the lottery if...

I register early in the lottery application window?

No. It does not matter when you submit your application as long as you do so before the deadline of midnight January 13.

I register for multiple weeks?

No. Each family should submit one application. Whether your family is requesting one week or a full summer, you will only be counted once in the lottery.

I register multiple children?

No. Each family will be counted one time.

I am trying to coordinate camp registration with another family; how do I do that?

Both families should submit separate lottery applications listing the same camp and week. At this time, we are not able to process multiple family applications.

Can I register my child and their friend for camp?

Yes. However, their names should be listed together on one lottery application. So in this instance, if the parents of your child's friend do not submit an application, then you can include your child and their friend on your application.

Can I enter the lottery more than once?

No; each family should submit one lottery application.

What if I need to change my lottery application?

If you need to update your lottery application with an additional child or change your camp selection, please email <u>IMASummerCamp@discovernewfields.org</u>. All applications will be considered final once the lottery application window closes at midnight January 13.

What if I miss the lottery application deadline?

If you miss the lottery application window, you can still join a waiting list for your desired camps by emailing <u>IMASummerCamp@discovernewfields.org</u>. Your request will be processed in the order that we receive it, after we prioritize families who submitted a lottery application. Any open spots will be available for purchase after January 31, 2020.

If I receive a spot in camp, when do I pay for it?

The credit card that you submit with your lottery application form will be charged during the week of January 14-21. When your card is charged, you will receive an emailed confirmation. If you do not receive a spot in camp, your card will not be charged.

What happens to unfilled camps spots?

We anticipate that about 95% of camp spots will be filled via the lottery. Tickets will go on sale at 10 am for any remaining spots. If you are on a waitlist, you can register for these openings at this time.

Will I know what my waiting list ranking is?

Yes. Families will be notified via email with their position on the waiting list. If your child is placed on more than one waiting list, you will receive information about their position on all of the waiting lists that they are a part of.

When will I know if I am moved from the waiting list?

If a spot opens up in a camp, you will be notified via email by a Newfields staff member. You will have 72 hours to respond to the notification.

How likely am I to receive a camp spot while on the waiting list?

Though it is difficult to predict with certainty, you may have a good chance of coming off of a waiting list to join a camp. Because our camps fill up so early in the year, we often see cancellations through the spring.

What if I need to cancel my camp reservation?

We always appreciate knowing as soon as possible if you need to cancel your registration. Camp cancellations and refunds will be issued according to the following schedule: If you cancel your registration...

Between January 14 and February 29: campers are eligible for a full refund.
Between March 1 and April 15: campers are eligible for a full refund, minus a \$50 processing fee per registration. (For half day camps, the fee is \$25 per registration).
After April 15: no refunds will be given.
