

FAQs Summer Nights Presented by National Bank of Indianapolis (Updated 5/24)

TICKET FAQS

When do tickets go on sale for Summer Nights Presented by National Bank of Indianapolis?

Member tickets go on-sale on Friday, May 21 at 11 AM and public tickets go on-sale on Friday, May 28 at 11 AM.

How much are tickets?

Ticket boxes of four are \$36 for members and \$48 for public. New this year and to maintain a safe social distance and reduced capacity in <u>The Amphitheater</u>, Summer Nights tickets will be sold as boxed seating that can accommodate one to four individuals. Each box will be seven feet by eight feet and be spaced six feet apart from others. Tickets go on sale for members on May 21 at 11 a.m. and for the public on May 28 at 11 a.m.

Can I buy one, two or three tickets at a time?

No. Each box is \$36 for members and \$48 for public. For everyone's health and safety, the boxes will be sold at a fixed price with a maximum of four tickets.

Do I have to have four people to attend?

No, you are welcome to have fewer than four people in your box, but the cost of tickets will still be \$36 for members and \$48 for public guests.

Where do I buy my tickets?

Visit discover**newfields**.org to purchase your tickets to Summer Nights.

Do I have to buy my tickets online in advance?

Yes. To limit onsite capacity and overall crowd size, advance tickets for all guests and members is required.

If it rains will Summer Nights still happen?

Depends. Summer Nights is a fair-weather event. If the screening is cancelled due to inclement weather or if the screening is halted less than 45 minutes into the screening guests will receive a full refund. Check Newfields website and social media for updates on the weather before you head out to the movie. Ticket holders will receive an email about any changes to the scheduled film screening.

General FAQS

Are all the films in English?

No. Pan's Labrynth on June 19 is in Spanish and will have English subtitles and Yojimbo on July 23 is in Japanese and will also have English subtitles.

COVID FAQS

Are masks required during Summer Nights?

Guests to Summer Nights are required to wear a face mask if not fully vaccinated. Guests may remove their masks only when seated in their designated box when they are not within six feet of guests outside of their party.

Is social distancing taken into account for Summer Nights?

Yes! Each grouping of four tickets will be separated by six feet from the groups on either side of them.

Is The Amphitheater operating at a limited capacity?

Yes. The Ampitheater will be operating at 40% capacity throughout the run of Summer Nights.
